Finance

- o As of August 14, the Town has collected:
 - \$1,586,130 (95%) of the annual property tax billing (\$1,674,899)
 - \$846,444 (88%) of the July quarterly utility billing (\$971,701)
 - ✓ Collections still in alignment with prior quarters
- o Processed Accounts Payable, Accounts Receivable, and Payroll

Wastewater

- o Lagoon depths: Large Lagoon is 5.50 feet and Small Lagoon is 2.50 feet
- o Completed grass cutting and trim at the treatment facility
- Cut and re-threaded several tall risers in our spray field to lower the risers for the weed spraying equipment to access the field
- Cleaned out grease buildup in the stilling tube at Del-Tech pump station that was interfering with the level transducer operation

- o Automatic hydrant flushing devices installed at three (3) locations
- o New gate at Public Works Yard installed
- Ongoing grass cutting


