Monthly Commentary

The State's April seasonally adjusted unemployment rate remained unchanged from March at 4.5%, while the number of jobs in the State grew by a net 8,000 or 1.8% over the year. Delaware's Labor Force Participation (LFP) rate was 61.2 percent in April, 0.8 percentage points lower than a year ago. Delaware's LFP reached 59.4 percent in April 2020, the lowest point on record, dating back to 1976. The U.S. LFP rate, 62.2 percent, was a net increase of 0.5 percentage points from the year prior, driven by increased women and minority participation.

Delaware Labor Force Trends

Delaware's seasonally adjusted unemployment rate in April 2022 was 4.5%, unchanged from March 2022. There were 22,400 unemployed Delawareans in April 2022 compared to 28,600 in April 2021. The US unemployment rate was 3.6% in April 2022, unchanged from March 2022. In April 2021, the US unemployment rate was 6.0%, while Delaware's rate was 5.8%.

In April 2022, seasonally adjusted nonfarm employment was 456,700, up from 456,000 in March 2022. Since April 2021, Delaware's total nonfarm jobs have increased by a net gain of 8,000, a rise of 1.8%. Nationally, jobs during that period increased 4.6%.


