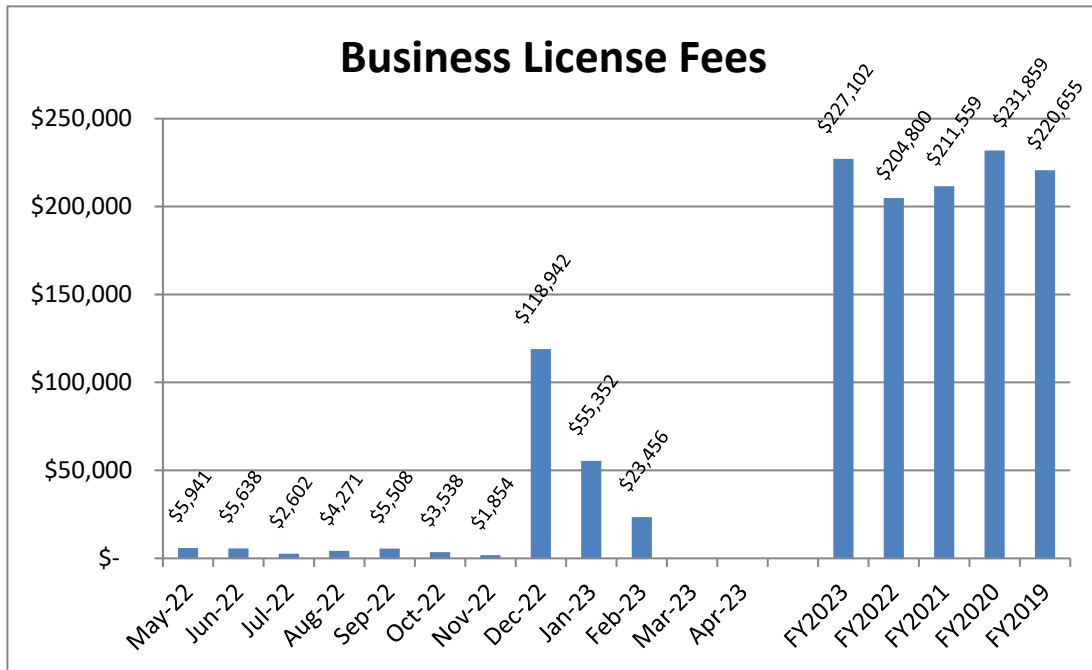
Key Revenue Items

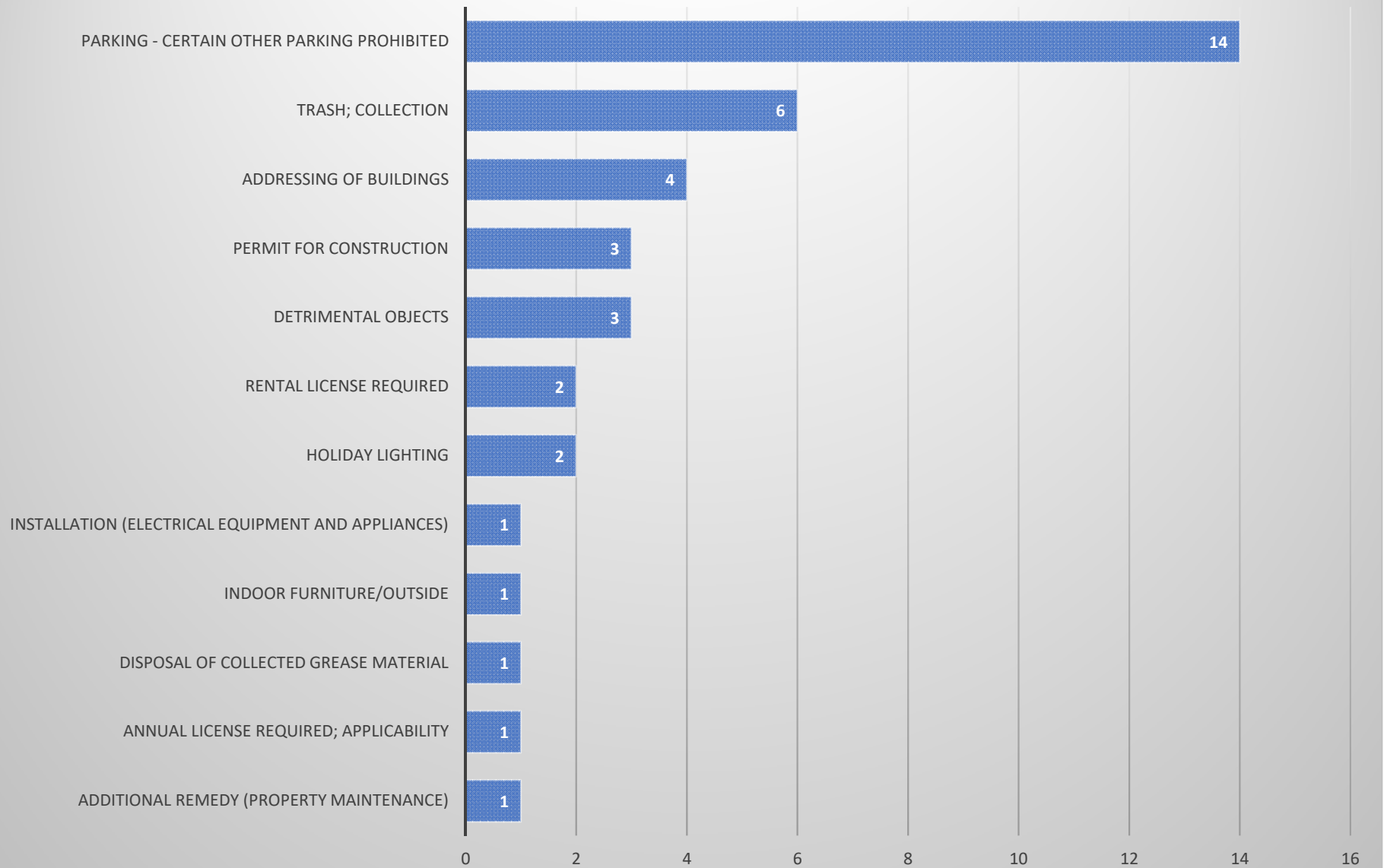

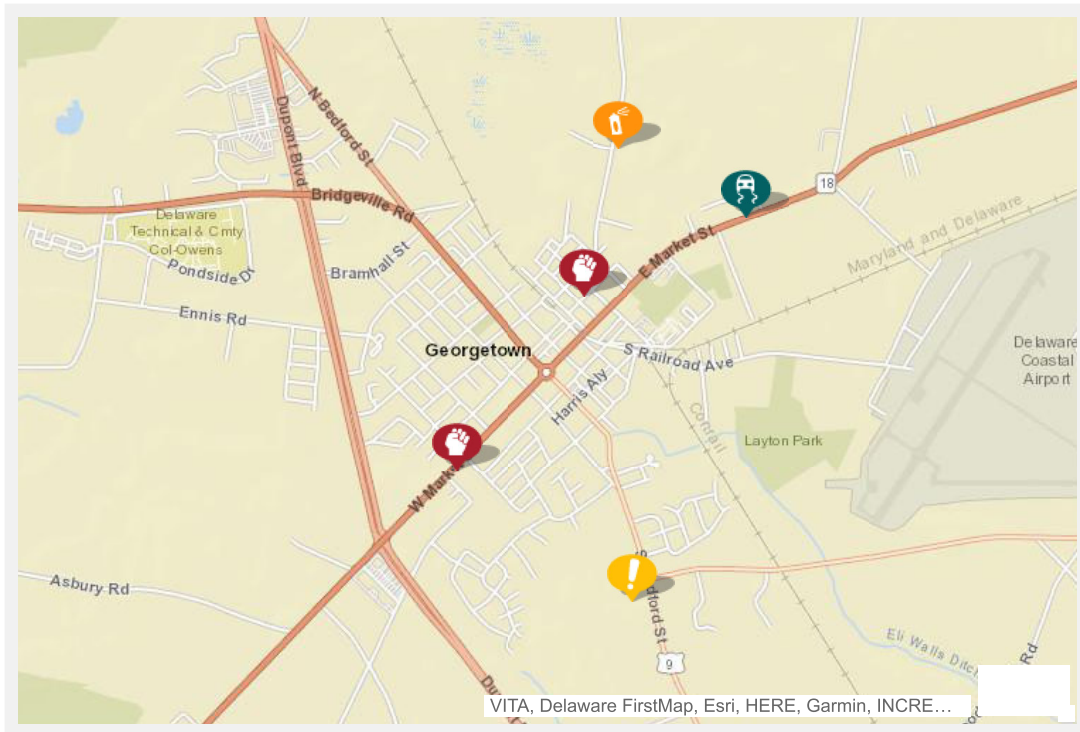

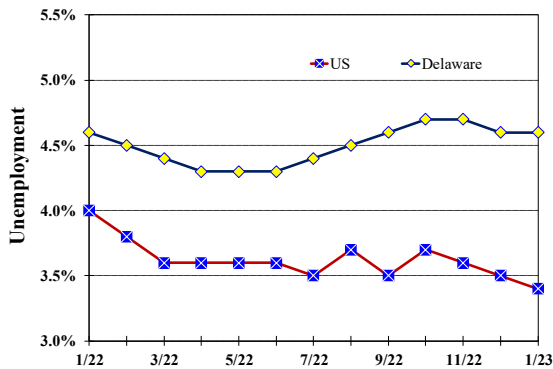

Monthly Commentary

Delaware jobs were 14,600 higher in January than a year ago and increased 2,300 over-the-month of December. The Trade, Transportation, and Utility sector led over-the-year job growth with 4,000 new jobs. Increases in the Professional & Business Services and Financial Activities industries also grew by 2,400 and 2,200 jobs, respectively. Average hourly wages were \$30.50 in January, 0.97 cents or 3.3 percent higher than in January 2022. By comparison, the national consumer price index (CPI) rose 6.4 percent over-the-year, a percentage growth nearly twice as large as the growth in the average hourly wage.

Delaware Labor Force Trends

Delaware's seasonally adjusted unemployment rate in January 2023 was 4.6%, unchanged from December 2022. There were 22,900 unemployed Delawareans in January 2023 compared to 23,100 in January 2022. The US unemployment rate was 3.4% in January 2023, down from 3.5% in December 2022. In January 2022, the US unemployment rate was 4.0%, while Delaware's rate was 4.6%.

In January 2023, seasonally adjusted nonfarm employment was 479,300, up from 477,000 in December 2022. Since January 2022, Delaware's total nonfarm jobs have increased by a net gain of 14,600, a rise of 3.2%. Nationally, jobs during that period increased 3.3%.

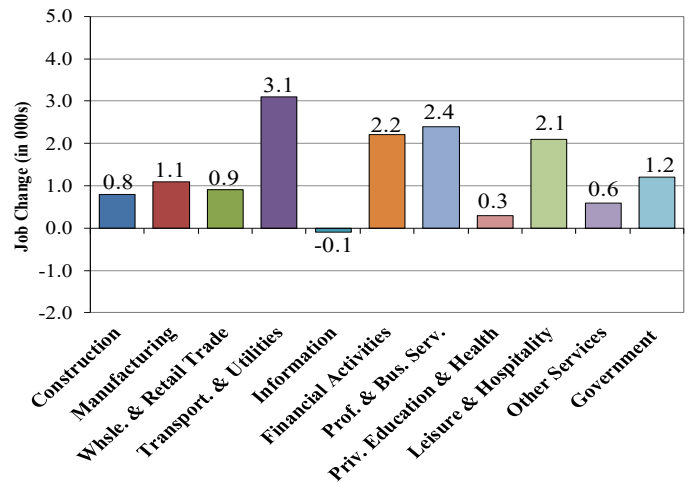
