**501 and 503 East Market Street – SC Tax Parcels 135-15.13-16.00
and 135-15.13-17.00**

(1) Comprehensive Plan Amendment: Future Land Use Map

(2) Rezone Application

A proposal by the Town of Georgetown for the following: (1) an amendment to the Town of Georgetown's Comprehensive Plan Future Land Use Map for two parcels, totaling 0.91 +/- acres, from Commercial to Single-Family Residential, and (2) an official zoning map amendment for two parcels, totaling 0.91 +/- acres, from HC Highway Commercial to UR1 Urban Residential.

The properties are located at 501 and 503 East Market Street, zoned HC Highway Commercial, identified as SC Tax Parcels 135-15.13-16.00 and 135-15.13-17.00.

Applications and proposed amendments are available for public inspection at the Town Administrative Offices, 37 The Circle, during the hours of 8:00 AM – 4:30 PM, Monday through Friday or electronically, upon request. It is recommended that any written comments be forwarded 24 hours in advance of the meeting to ensure all documentation is forwarded to the Commission to review prior to the meeting.
